Course Outline for Bible

I. Course Description

This course consists of three elements:

- A. Character development and Bible Study
The student will study different Bible books and topics from a Biblical perspective and have opportunity to apply what is learned to daily life.
- B. Bible memorization, prayer, and devotions
The student will be required to memorize scripture verses and will be encouraged to have regular devotions.
- C. Service to God
The student will be required to serve in a ministry on a regular basis.

 - 6. The student will complete an AWANA elective manual.
- B. Bible memorization, prayer, and devotions
 - 1. The student will be able to recall scripture memorized when needed for daily living.
 - 2. The student will develop a personal relationship with God.
 - 3. The student will be able to see the power of prayer.
 - 4. The student will seek God's guidance for his/her life.
 - 5. The student will develop discernment of events in the world and relate them to scripture.
- C. Service to God.
 - 1. The student will be able to share the Bible with children.
 - 2. The student will become concerned about the salvation and needs of others.
 - 3. The student will be able to share the Gospel.
 - 4. The student will realize the importance of Godly character.
 - 5. The student will be able to resolve uncertainties about his/her personal faith.
