I. Course Description

Youth Walk will help the student answer questions to 26 different topics of concern for teens. Each lesson starts with an introduction previewing the week's topic. A devotional page for each day of the week, Monday through Friday surveys five different aspects of the problem. Each devotional page will have an Opening Story to start you thinking about the problem. A Look it Up shows what God's Word says about the problem. A Think it Through helps the student understand what God's Word means. A Work it Out encourages him to put the Bible to work as he deals with the problem, and a Nail it Down section offers more insights on God's answer.
