



Bus Driver

Under the direction of the Transportation Supervisor, operate a school bus providing safe and efficient transportation to DCS students and staff to and from school functions, sporting events, and field trips; assure the safety of the vehicle by performing inspections prior to operation, cleaning and maintenance; prepare, maintain, and submit, in a timely manner, records and reports related to miles driven; maintain order on the bus as required and assist in the loading and unloading of students as necessary. Work hours/days will vary based upon transportation needs.

Requirements:

- High school diploma or equivalent;
- Ability to pass a medical examination;
- Ability to pass mandated alcohol and controlled substance tests;
- Ability to pass Department of Justice fingerprint clearance;
- Within the preceding three years have not had driving privileges revoked or suspended, or have been placed on probation for any reason involving the unsafe operation of a motor vehicle; and
- Ability to lift 50 pounds.

Recommendations (but will provide training for the right candidate):

- A valid class B driver's license with passenger endorsement, and
- Possession of a California Special Driver Certificate (School Bus).
